As of July 1, 2006, RADVISION Ltd. is in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, including the Restriction of Hazardous Substance in electrical products (ROHS).

RADVISION works with its supply chain partners and others in the industry, including material and components suppliers, to ensure every aspect of its business is in accordance with these requirements.

The RoHS directive is complementary to the WEEE directive. It bans the use of certain heavy metals and brominated flame retardants in order to reduce the environmental impact of land filled.

As of August 13, 2005, all RADVISION products on the market were identified as complying with the directives, and marked with a crossed-out "wheelie bin" symbol according to the WEEE directives.

RADVISION understands the environmental risks associated with these substances and complies with the RoHS directive requirements set by the European Union.
