**RADVISION EXPANDS ITS SERVICE PROVIDER PORTFOLIO
WITH ANNOUNCEMENT OF VIDEO STREAMING SOLUTION**

*Initial Application Enables Streaming of Content from RTSP Streaming Servers
and Network Cameras to 3G Mobile Devices*

-- **RADVISION (Nasdaq: RVSN)** today announced the latest addition to its portfolio of products for the wireless and wireline service provider market with the *viaIP*TM Multimedia Streaming Solution. This solution, which is currently in advanced trials with a number of major 3G operators and is being used by a number of major equipment vendors' for live demonstrations at the 3GSM World Congress, enables carriers to offer high-margin multimedia streaming services to their wireline and wireless customers.

The solution will be initially available in the mobile market, where it meets a growing need by service providers to offer revenue-generating, real-time multimedia services such as mobile television, video streaming, remote surveillance, and video-on-demand – all over a broadband wireless connection such as 3G. Later this year RADVISION plans to roll out solutions and services based on this technology to the wireline service provider, enabling the delivery of video-on-demand and other multimedia streaming services to residential customers over their broadband IP connection.

This solution provides a seamless bridge between the RTSP (Real Time Streaming Protocol) devices and IP or 3G endpoints, and will be sold both as a stand alone platform or can also be integrated into the same *viaIP* platform carriers are currently using to deliver other RADVISION-enabled multimedia services to residential and mobile customers.

“Broadband mobile video services no longer mean just video telephony. While there is significant interest in two-way video telephony, service providers are also very interested in multimedia streaming - offering their customers real-time video from servers, television stations, or security cameras/facilities to 3G end points - be that a phone, a PDA, or a 3G-enabled laptop,” said Eli Doron, RADVISION CTO and Senior Vice President of Service Provider Strategy. “With the RADVISION solution in their network, a mobile carrier will be able to offer its subscribers a world of multimedia content – creating increased broadband usage and new high-margin revenue streams.”

The RADVISION *viaIP* Multimedia Streaming Solution is a powerful solution that is scalable to serve any number of concurrent users and multiple streaming servers and network cameras, and features SNMP management and control tools, enabling the carrier to easily manage a session or network from a centralized location. At the core of this new *viaIP* Multimedia Streaming Solution are the management systems, RTSP proxy, 3G-324M gateway, call control, and feature servers necessary to convert and direct one-way and multipoint video and multimedia content from RTSP sources to the 3G broadband cellular device.
